Players

- Play for the fun of it.
- How you play is more important than winning or losing.
- Accept the official's decisions even if you think they are wrong. Play by the rules!
- Be a good sport, applaud good play whether by your team or your opponents.
- Control your temper at all times and treat all players as you would like to be treated.

Coaches

- Teach your players that the rules of the game are mutual agreements which they shouldn't break.
- Remember that young people play for fun and enjoyment, winning is only part of it.
- Never yell at players for making mistakes!
- Do not publicly question any official's decisions and never doubt his or her honesty.
- Be generous with your praise and set a good example.
- Set a good example by upholding the Leagues No Smoking policy.

Spectators

- Remember that the young people are involved for their enjoyment not yours.
- You have a responsibility to encourage the players to abide by the rules.
- Help to remove all verbal and physical abuse in football by setting a good example.
- Applaud good play and never publicly question a referee's decision.
- Respect team work and effort as much as winning.
- Help young people to accept defeat without undue disappointment.
